

He is currently the host of *Sunday Evenings* on ABC Local Radio. From 2004 to 2011 he hosted *The New Inventors* on ABC-TV, and from 2002 to 2006 he hosted *The Evening Show* on ABC Local Radio.

James began performing stand-up comedy in 1990 and for most of the 1990s managed to combine a successful comedy career with a day job as a criminal lawyer.

He is the author of five books and is a leading MC, facilitator and speaker on innovation.

His book **SIR RODERICK THE NOT-VERY BRAVE** won the 2014 Speech Pathology Award for the best book for 8-10 year olds.

FROM JAMES TO YOU

Hi, I'm James O'Loughlin.

You may have seen my first novel for children, *The Adventures of Sir Roderick the Not-Very Brave*, in 2014.

In April 2015, Pan Macmillan will publish my new story, *Daisy Malone and the Blue Glowing Stone*.

Daisy is a 12-year-old girl who has a talking dog called Ben. One day two men – one very sinister, the other very stupid – break into her house and steal a blue, glowing stone that is hidden in the attic. But who hid it there and why? And why do the men want it? And where has Daisy's mum disappeared to? And why does her dad get so scared every time a door slams? And why do I keep asking you questions that I know the answers to but you don't?

By the end of the book, of course, all those questions (except the last one) have been answered because that's what stories do: they ask questions and then eventually answer them. But the message I really want to convey to you about *Daisy Malone and the Blue Glowing Stone* is that it's funny. Some critics described *The Adventures of Sir Roderick the Not-Very Brave* as funny (in fact as 'very funny'* and 'hilarious'**), but *Daisy Malone* is really funny.

It has 324 pages and my aim was to get something funny on every page, as well as to create a cracking adventure story.


