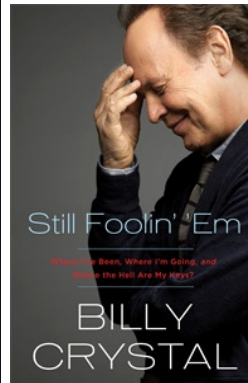

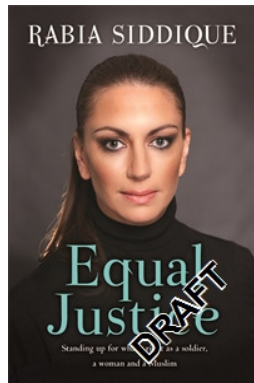

She became a lawyer, moved to the UK and joined the British army as a military lawyer.
