His actions earned him an Army Commendation Medal with "V" for Valor. He had previously been awarded a Bronze Star for Valor - and a total of three Purple Hearts for combat wounds. *Back in the Fight* is an inspiring and thrilling tale readers will never forget.

SFC Joe Kapaczewski is the only amputee in Army Rangers history to return to combat, serving nine tours in the Middle East.
