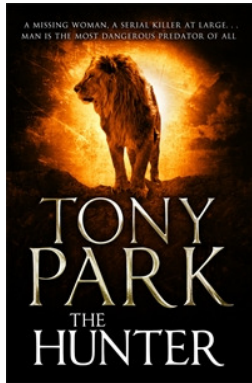

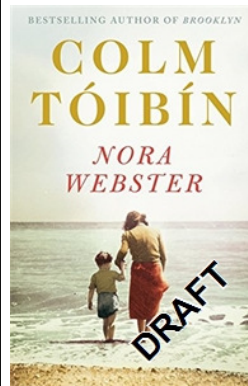

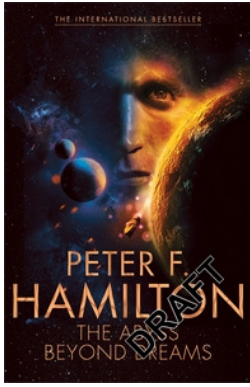
The Abyss Beyond Dreams*

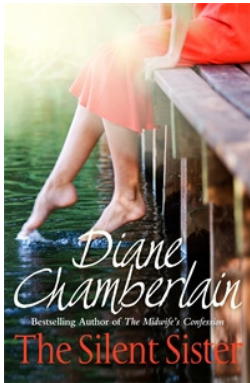

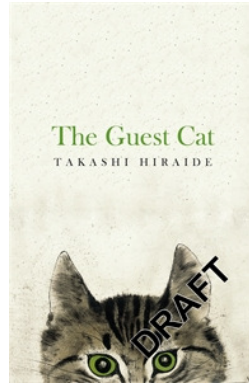
The Guest Cat
